The film presents a dull, gray room arranged as a set, depicting the monotonous daily routine of a white-collar worker before leaving home. Throughout the film, there is a continuous inner monologue, sometimes from the character and sometimes from the director, portraying a self-contradiction. I am both trapped in the daily role as a character and also the self-observer, the director, who is above the character. However, even the director cannot change the predetermined role in this cycle of daily repetition. As stated in the voiceover in the film: "You have no choice, everything is planned. I am like an actor, controlled by the director, including the accidents, making it impossible for me to distinguish reality. What should I do?"
